### Northeast Middle School Information Night

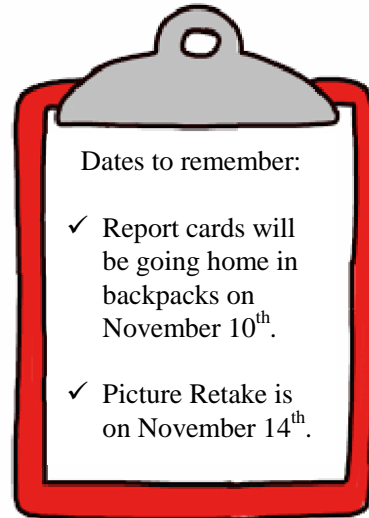

Ms. Beasley's class were the top gatherers with a total of \$481, and Ms. Morris' class a close second with \$461.



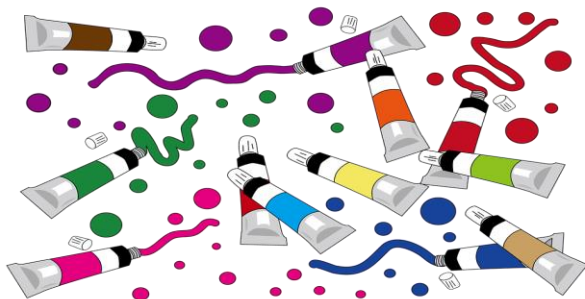
### Give to the Max Day
