What is the PTA?

The purpose of the Waite Park Community School PTA is to promote the health and welfare of children and youth and promote collaboration between parents, the school, and the community. We do this by organizing family activities, coordinating volunteers, and planning and hosting crucial fundraising programs and events that support school activities and initiatives. Our Waite Park Community School PTA is organized under the authority of the Minnesota Congress of Parents, Teachers and Students (Minnesota PTSA), a branch of the National Congress of Parents and Teachers (National PTA).

PTA = Parent Teacher Association

When does the PTA meet?

The PTA holds monthly meetings during the school year. In 2018-2019, these meetings are on the second Thursday of the month, from 6 – 7:30 p.m. in the Waite Park Rec Center Multipurpose Room.

Who is on the PTA?

The PTA is made up of families and school staff – all are welcome to attend. There are four (4) PTA officer positions that are elected annually. These positions are responsible for working with the school staff and PTA volunteers to set priorities and oversee the business of the PTA. The positions and their roles are as follows:

- **President** – The PTA president presides at monthly meetings, helps to develop and serve as an Ex-officio member on all PTA committees, and coordinates the work of the officers and committees.
- **Vice-president** – The PTA vice-president acts as aide to the president and performs the duties of the president in the absence or inability of that officer to serve.
- **Secretary** – The PTA secretary records the minutes of all meetings, keeps a current copy of the bylaws, maintains an up-to-date membership list, and performs other duties as assigned.
- **Treasurer** – The PTA treasurer manages the PTA funds, keeps accounting of expenditures and makes payments in accordance with the budget, and presents a financial statement at the monthly PTA meeting.

What can I do?

PTA success is dependent on family and staff involvement. There are many opportunities to get involved. In addition to the monthly planning and business meetings, there are committees to help plan activities, promote school and community events, raise funds and make funding decisions.
